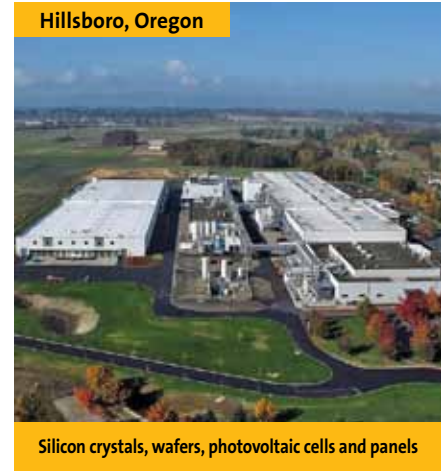
## SolarWorld can tell you
